And you have lingered there my sister

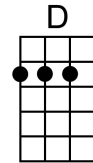

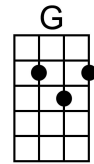

Please do not hold on to me, we all must go a-lo - o - one

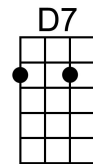

With the sharing of a brand new song



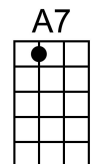
